



Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Holden Kindergarten! We look forward to teaching your child this August. Below is a list of a few skills that your child should have before entering school in August. Please work with your child during the summer to enable them to enter school and be ready to learn on a Kindergarten level.

1. Recognize colors.
2. Count to 30 and recognize numbers 0-10.
3. Recite full name, birthday, age, and name of town they live in.
4. Be able to tie their shoes.
5. Know how to correctly use pencils, scissors, and crayons.
6. **Print first name correctly. (uppercase on first letter only, example: Mary)**
7. Recognize all letters and sounds of the alphabet.
8. Read, Read, Read to your child ☺
9. Practice rhyming

**Supplies** - We will collect a \$40.00 workbook/supply fee at the beginning of the year. We will purchase most of your child's school supplies for the year; however, we ask that you send a few items. These are the items we are certain of for now, **but we may add some things** that will be included in the letter we will mail to you at the end of the summer. Please label the items with your child's name. These items are:

1. Book sack (**regular size and shape; no rolling wheels, PLEASE!**)
2. Thick coloring book
3. Thin Foldable **red/blue** rest mat (**not the thick ones** as we do not have enough storage space)
4. 1 Box of Kleenex
5. 2 Rolls of paper towels
6. 1 Box of baby wipes
7. 1 Pack of brown paper lunch bags
8. Girls bring these: one box of quart size zip-loc bags
9. Boys bring these: one box of gallon size zip-loc bags
10. 1 Pack of Band-Aids (varied sizes please)
11. Headphones labeled with your child's name (**NO** earbuds)

**\*Rest mat covers are not allowed in kindergarten. Your child will be allowed to bring a small blanket that will go back and forth in their book sacks daily.**

**Beginning of Year Schedule.** The Kindergarten year will begin differently from the rest of the grades. This is a parish-wide schedule. Please note these dates below.

**Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (August 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022)** will be testing days for Kindergarten students. You will bring your student for approximately 30 minutes on one of these days. You will receive a letter during the summer advising you when to bring your child. After the test is completed, you will take your student home until the date listed below.

**Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>** – All Kindergarten girls will attend school for a full day; boys will not attend on this day.

**Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup>** – All Kindergarten boys will attend school for a full day; girls will not attend on this day.

**Tuesday, August 16<sup>th</sup>** – All Kindergarten students will attend beginning today.

Again, you will receive a letter at the **end** of the summer reminding you of these dates as well as your child's testing date and time. We look forward to a great year with you and your student!
